Karim Labib did his PhD studies in the group of Paul Nurse at the University of Oxford, before postdoctoral periods with Sergio Moreno in Salamanca, Stephen Kearsey in Oxford and John Diffley in London. In 2001, Karim started his group in what is now the Cancer Research UK Manchester Research Institute. Karim joined the EMBO Young Investigator Programme in 2004 and in 2010 was elected a member of EMBO and received the Hooke medal from the British Society for Cell Biology. In 2013, Karim moved his group to the MRC Protein Phosphorylation and Ubiquitylation Unit at the University of Dundee in Scotland. In 2016, Karim was elected as a fellow of the Royal Society of Edinburgh.
