Ilaria is a Principal Group Leader at the Francis Crick Institute, she has a long-standing interest in understanding the cancer cells functional heterogeneity driving their tumourigenic potential.

After a PhD at the DKFZ in Heidelberg did her Postdoctoral training at the ISREC, Federal University (EPFL) of Lausanne, Switzerland. During these Postdoc years she began to investigate the importance of tumour microenvironment during metastatic progression. Building on this expertise in mouse tumour models, Ilaria set up her laboratory at the Cancer Research UK London Research Institute in 2011 (now part of the Francis Crick Institute) and has since focused the scope of investigation on the interaction that cancer cells have with the surrounding tissue cells during tumorigenesis and metastatic progression. Ilaria was promoted to Principal Group Leader at the Francis Crick Institute in 2018 and become EMBO member in 2021.
