

## Biosketch:

Fátima Gebauer is Senior Group Leader and Co-coordinator of the Genome Biology Program at the Centre for Genomic Regulation (CRG, Barcelona, Spain). She received her PhD in 1990 from the Autónoma University of Madrid, and performed postdocs in the labs of Drs Joel Richter (UMass, USA) and Matthias Hentze (EMBL, Germany). In 2000, she obtained a staff scientist position at EMBL, followed by a fully independent position at the CRG in 2002. Fátima is EMBO member, member of Academia Europaea, Associate editor of the RNA Journal, President of the RNA Society, and Vice-president of the European network on Translation and Cancer 'Translacore'. Research in her lab centers on RNA-binding proteins and mechanisms of translational control in human cancer (mostly melanoma). Approaches include high-throughput methods (iCLIP, RNA-Seq, polysome-Seq, RIC, proteomics), biochemistry and pre-clinical models.
